All CMDP members can get family planning and birth control services provided at no cost.

Have the information you need to make good choices for yourself. Talk with your doctor, DCS Specialist, probation officer or foster caregivers to help in your family planning decisions. If you need help with getting services or more information, call a nurse. A CMDP Nurse is available at 602-351-2245 or 1-800-201-1795. You do not need to give us your name to find out more about these services.

CMDP COVERS THESE SERVICES, PROVIDED BY YOUR DOCTOR, AT NO CHARGE:

- Annual physical exams (including radiological procedures if needed)
- Lab tests
- Testing, treatment and counseling for sexually transmitted diseases (STDs), including Chlamydia
- Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) testing and counseling
- Education on preventing pregnancy, choosing not to have sex (abstinence) and STDs
- Prescribed birth control supplies and education:
- Birth control pills
- Birth control injections (Depo Provera)
- Birth control implants
- Condoms (male and female)
- Diaphragms and sponges
- Intrauterine Device (IUD)
- Birth Control Patches
- Spermicides and lubrication
- Emergency contraception (Plan B or Ella)
