What you need to know starting April 1, 2021

Mercy Care and the Department of Child Safety formed a partnership to provide integrated health care for children in foster care. This means that children in foster care will get their physical, dental and behavioral health care from a single health plan – Mercy Care Department of Child Safety Comprehensive Health Plan, or Mercy Care DCS CHP.

This new integrated health plan will replace CMDP beginning April 1, 2021. Children in foster care can access the same covered services with Mercy Care DCS CHP as they do with CMDP and the Regional Behavioral Health Authorities (RBHAs).
