1. Victim: Isabelle Fairbanks – 3-year-old female

6. Alleged perpetrator(s) name, age and city, town or general location:

Jason Fairbanks - age 39 - Scottsdale, AZ

7. Circumstances of the fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:

On May 8, 2018, the Department of Child Safety received a report regarding the death of 3-year-old Isabelle Fairbanks. Upon investigation it was determined that on November 10, 2017, Jason Fairbanks shot and killed his two children and their mother before committing suicide.

8. Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s)**:

DCS has received no prior reports involving Isabelle or Jason Fairbanks.

9. Actions taken by DCS in response to the fatality:

A joint investigation was conducted with Scottsdale Police Department.

10. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:

There were no surviving children in the home.

11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:

No services were provided by the Department.
