Rachel Henry – age 23

**7. Circumstances of the fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:**

On January 20, 2020, the Department of Child Safety received a report stating Mireya Henry was pronounced deceased at home. The mother, Rachel Henry, was indicted by a Grand Jury on January 27, 2020 for 3 counts of First Degree Murder.

**8. Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s)\*\*:**

DCS received no prior reports involving Rachel Henry and/or Mireya Henry.

**9. Actions taken by DCS in response to the fatality:**

A joint investigation is being conducted with the Phoenix Police Department.

**10. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:**

There are no other children in the home at this time.

**11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:**

No services are being provided by the Department at this time.
