1. Victim: Kaoir Harris – 6-week-old female

6. Alleged perpetrator(s) name, age and city, town or general location:

Sara Lashae Harris – age 23 – Phoenix, AZ

7. Circumstances of the fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:

On July 30, 2023, the Department of Child Safety received a report regarding 6-week-old, Kaoir Harris, being found deceased at her home. Upon investigation it was determined the child was left unattended for 37 hours. On January 5, 2024, the mother, Sara Lashae Harris, was arrested and charged with 2nd degree murder and child abuse due to Kaoir's death.

8. Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s)**:

DCS received the following prior report involving Sara Lashae Harris:

On February 10, 2023, a report was received alleging physical abuse to children by Sara Lashae Harris. The allegations were unsubstantiated. The family was provided with community resources and the case was closed on February 22, 2023.

9. Actions taken by DCS in response to the fatality:

A joint investigation was conducted with the Phoenix Police Department.

10. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:

Following an assessment of child safety, the other children in the home were placed with a relative.

11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:
