Jayden's body had been found in the desert by a passerby on May 11, 2017 around 11:15am. She had been reported missing earlier that morning. She was pronounced deceased on scene. The child's stepfather, Joshua Lelevier, was arrested on May 31, 2017 for first degree murder.

# 8. Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s)\*\*:

DCS has received no prior reports involving Jayden Glomb.

DCS has received no prior reports involving Joshua Lelevier as an alleged perpetrator.

### 9. Actions taken by DCS in response to the fatality:

A joint investigation is being conducted with the Tucson Police Department.

#### 10. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:

Following an assessment of child safety, the other children in the home were assessed as being safe.

# 11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:

The Department intends to provide services as the investigation continues.
