7. Circumstances of the near fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:

On April 25, 2017, the Department of Child Safety received a report regarding a one-month-old child who was taken to the hospital. Upon examination, the child was determined to be in critical condition with severe head trauma. On April 20, 2018, the Maricopa County Juvenile Court found through a severance proceeding that the child “was abused in the exclusive care of mother and father...”

8. Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s) **:

DCS has received no prior reports involving Sergio Madrid and/or the near fatality victim.

DCS has received the following prior reports involving Sandra Holguin Rey:

On December 24 2004, a report was received alleging neglect of the victim’s sibling by their mother, Sandra Holguin Rey. The Department unsubstantiated the allegation of neglect against the mother and the case was closed.

On July 26, 2011, a report was received alleging neglect of the victim’s siblings by their mother, Sandra Holguin Rey. The investigation of that report resulted in the victim’s siblings being placed in out-of-home care. The Department filed a dependency petition with the Maricopa County Juvenile Court and the allegations were substantiated. The dependency was dismissed and the case was closed in August 2012 after the family successfully completed services.

9. Actions taken by DCS in response to the near fatality:

A joint investigation was conducted with the Phoenix PD.

10. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:

Following an assessment of child safety, the other children in the home were placed with relatives. Upon release from the hospital, the near fatality victim was placed in a medically fragile foster home.



11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:

The Department is providing services to the family.

*The determination that a fatality or near fatality is the result of abuse, abandonment or neglect is based one or more of the following criteria: (1) The perpetrator(s) arrest related to the incident, (2) Substantiated finding(s) linking the alleged perpetrator(s) action(s) to the fatality or near fatality and/or (3) Results of the Medical Examiner's report.

** Information released after July 3, 2015 provides reports, or any current or past cases, of abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the alleged perpetrator pursuant to A.R.S. § 8-807.01(A)(1)(e).
