**6. Alleged perpetrator(s) name, age and city, town or general location:**

Jennifer Ivanisko – age 24 – Phoenix, AZ  
Daniel Gonzalez – age 30 – Phoenix, AZ

**7. Circumstances of the near fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:**

On August 31, 2016, the Department of Child Safety received a report regarding a two year old near fatality victim who was taken to the hospital after receiving a gunshot wound to his groin. On January 9, 2017, the father, Daniel Gonzalez, was indicted on charges of child abuse. The allegation of neglect pertaining to Daniel Gonzalez was substantiated as he failed to provide supervision when he allowed a firearm to be stored in an unlocked and unsecured manner within reach of the near fatality victim.

The allegation of neglect pertaining to the mother, Jennifer Invanisko, was substantiated as she failed to provide supervision when she allowed a firearm to be stored in an unlocked and unsecured manner within reach of the near fatality victim.

**8. Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s)\*\*:**

DCS has received the following prior report involving Jennifer Ivanisko:

On February 7, 2014, a report was received alleging neglect to a child by Jennifer Ivanisko. The allegations were unsubstantiated as to Jennifer Ivanisko. The family was provided with information on services available in the community and the case was closed.

**9. Actions taken by DCS in response to the near fatality:**

A joint investigation is being conducted with the Phoenix Police Department

**10. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:**

A safety plan was implemented with relatives for the sibling and the near fatality victim upon his release from the hospital. The children were later determined as safe and the Department is providing services to the family.

**11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:**
