5. **County and general location of the residence of the victim:** Apache County

6. **Alleged perpetrator(s) name, age and city, town or general location:**

Amber Rawls – age 16 – Apache County
Dannum Neller – age 25 – Apache County

7. **Circumstances of the near fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:**

On March 15, 2016, the Department of Child Safety received a report regarding a 5-month-old baby who had been taken to the hospital after having seizures at home. The baby was found to be in critical condition with injuries including an acute subdural hematoma on her head, bleeding in the brain, retinal hemorrhages in both eyes, and four fractured ribs approximately two weeks old. The allegation of neglect pertaining to the mother, Amber Rawls, was substantiated for inflicting abuse and/or allowing the child to be abused as well as for neglecting the child by failing to protect. **The mother's boyfriend, Dannum Neller, was also residing in the home where the near fatality occurred. The Department substantiated the allegation of neglect pertaining Dannum Neller for inflicting abuse and/or allowing the child to be abused.**

8. **Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s)**:**

DCS has received no prior reports involving Dannum Neller.

DCS has received the following prior report involving Amber Rawls and the near fatality victim:

On February 10, 2016, report was received alleging neglect to the child by her mother, Amber Rawls. The investigation assessed the baby as safe with her mother and the allegation was unsubstantiated. The mother declined voluntary in-home services offered by the Department and the case was closed.

9. **Actions taken by DCS in response to the near fatality:**

A joint investigation was conducted with the Apache County Sheriff's Office.

10. **Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:**

Upon release from the hospital, the child was placed in licensed foster care. Another child who lived part time in the home was assessed as safe with that child's other parent.



11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:

The Department provided services to the family.

*The determination that a fatality or near fatality is the result of abuse, abandonment or neglect is based one or more of the following criteria: (1) The perpetrator(s) arrest related to the incident, (2) Substantiated finding(s) linking the alleged perpetrator(s) action(s) to the fatality or near fatality and/or (3) Results of the Medical Examiner's report.
