**7. Circumstances of the fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:**

On April 14, 2020, the Department of Child Safety received a report regarding 2-year-old London Glass who had become unresponsive. The child was transported to the hospital, where she was pronounced deceased. It was later determined that she died from methadone intoxication/overdose. On July 7, 2021, the child's mother, Shae'd Bowen, was charged with first degree murder.

**8. Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child or the current alleged perpetrator(s)\*\*:**

DCS received the following prior reports involving Shae'd Bowen and/or London Glass:

On September 25, 2017, a report was received alleging neglect to London from her mother, Shae'd Bowen. The allegation was substantiated. The family was offered in-home services but declined to participate. The family was provided information on services available in the community and the case was closed.

On September 14, 2018, a report was received alleging neglect to a London Glass by another adult. The allegation was unsubstantiated and the case was closed.

**9. Actions taken by DCS in response to the fatality:**

A joint investigation was conducted with the Chandler Police Department.

**10. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:**

Following an assessment of child safety, the other children in the home were placed with relative. On April 17, 2020, the Department filed a dependency petition with the Maricopa County Juvenile Court.

**11. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:**

The Department is providing services to the family including services to support the other child involved.
