Summary Report	Fatality	04/16/2024

**1. Victim:** Andrea Herrera one-month-old female

## 2. Was the child residing in the child's home or in an out-of-home placement at the time of the fatality?

The child was residing in her home when the following incident occurred:

On August 4, 2023, the Department of Child Safety received a report regarding one-monthold Andrea Herrera who was found unresponsive at the home while in the care of her father, Bryan Andres Herrera-Ruiz. She was transported to the hospital and later passed away due to non-accidental head trauma. The father, Bryan Andres Herrera-Ruiz, has been charged with first degree murder and child abuse due to Andrea's death.

### 3. If the victim in the Preliminary Report involved a child residing in the child's home, the following information will be provided:

a. Services being provided to the child, a member of the child's family or the person suspected of the abuse or neglect at the time of the incident and the date of the last contact before the incident between the entity providing services and the person receiving services:

Although no services were being provided to the family prior to the August 4, 2023, near fatality incident, the family was being investigated for an open report dated July 6, 2023. The last date of contact between the Department and the family was on July 10, 2023.

## b. Was the child, a member of the child's family or the person suspected of the abuse or neglect the subject of a report for investigation at the time of the incident?

The child and her parents were subjects of the July 6, 2023 report.

#### c. All involvement of the child's parents and of the person suspected of the abuse or neglect in a situation for which a report for investigation was made or in services provided pursuant to this chapter in the five years preceding the incident:

DCS received one prior report involving the child, Andrea Herrera:

On July 6, 2023, a report was received alleging neglect to Andrea by her mother. The child was assessed as safe with mother and father, Bryan Andres Herrera-Ruiz. The investigation was pending when the fatality occurred. The allegation was later unsubstantiated and no services were offered to the family.



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# d. Any investigation pursuant to a report for investigation concerning the child, a member of the child's family or the person suspected of the abuse or neglect or services provided to the child or the child's family since the date of the incident involving the fatality:

The investigation of the fatality resulted in the child's father, Bryan Andres Herrera-Ruiz, being arrested and charged with first degree murder and child abuse. The other children in the home were assessed as being safe with the mother. No services were provided to the family. No subsequent reports of abuse or neglect were received regarding the family.

# 5. Actions taken by the Department in response to the case including any changes to policy or practice and/or recommendations for further changes in policies, practices, rules or statutes:

The Department conducted a joint investigation with Coolidge Police Department. The child's father, Bryan Andres Herrera-Ruiz, is being charged with first degree murder and child abuse. The other children in the home were assessed as being safe with the mother. No services were provided to the family. No subsequent reports of abuse or neglect were received regarding the family.

Additionally, in accordance with the DCS Strategic Plan for State Fiscal Year 2016 (FY16), multidisciplinary team (MDT) reviews of fatality and near fatality cases were implemented during the first quarter of FY16. The MDT reviews fatality and near fatality cases with prior DCS involvement, which are a key feature of the Strategic Plan and supports the objective of increasing the accuracy of safety and risk assessments in investigations.

Cases are reviewed by the MDT in order to identify any systemic factors, both internal and external to the Department that may have had an impact. The Department uses the aggregate data gathered through all of the MDT reviews to assess and guide future changes

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and/or recommendations to policies, practices, rules or statutes. Findings from these reviews are compiled into an annual report to be shared on the DCS website. The target date for release of the next report is December 1, 2024.

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
