

Building Resilient Families



Building Resilient Families can assist you in obtaining resources and services to help you meet your family's needs.

WHAT IS TO BE EXPECTED

Building Resilient Families providers will contact your family within 2 business days of a referral. Together with them, you will identify your family's needs and develop a plan. The provider agency will help connect you to resources in the community and provide services that together you decide are needed. Your family may receive these supports for up to four months.

Voluntary Services are provided only to families referred by the Department of Child Safety upon case closure and are intended to build on your family strengths.
