

DID YOU KNOW?



All CMDP members male and female can get family planning and birth control services.

Have the information you need to make good choices for yourself. Talk with your doctor, case manager, probation officer or foster caregivers to help in your family planning decisions. If you need help with getting services, a CMDP Nurse is available at 602-351-2245 or 1-800-201-1795. You do not need to give us your name to find out more about these services.

CMDP COVERED SERVICES PROVIDED BY YOUR DOCTOR:

- Annual physical exams (including radiological procedures if needed)
- Lab tests
- Testing, treatment and counseling for sexually transmitted diseases (STDs), including Chlamydia
- Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) testing (counseling advised if tested positive)
- Education on preventing pregnancy, choosing not to have sex (abstinence) and STDs
- Prescribed birth control supplies and education:
- Birth control pills and emergency contraception
- Birth control injections
- Birth control implants
- Condoms
- Diaphragms
- Intrauterine Device (IUD)
- Patches
- Spermicides

Family Planning services do not include abortion or abortion counseling.
