NOTICE OF COMBINED PUBLIC MEETING AND EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SAFETY (DCS) COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

AGENDA

1. Safety Assessment

A DCS representative will provide information pending modifications on the safety assessment specifically as a continuation to the present danger analysis discussion that took place at the November CAC meeting. The Committee will discuss and provide feedback regarding the implications of such pending modification in the areas represented by the various committee members. The Committee will discuss and provide feedback regarding ways they may be able to support the implementation of the changing tool.

2. Optimization of Kinship Placement

Ursula Garza will provide information about kinship supports and working with kinship caregivers. The Committee will discuss opportunities to improve information sharing and support kinship caregivers.

3. Process to Receive Access to Confidential Case Information

The Committee will be briefed on the possibility of hearing presentations of certain individual cases. The process for obtaining access to confidential case information will be explained, and the committee may take action to authorize the filing of a request with the court to obtain access to confidential case information. The Committee may vote to go into executive session to receive legal advice about this item.

4. Committee Efficacy

The Committee will discuss and take possible action regarding future Committee goals for being most effective in fulfilling its function. Legal actions may be taken in the course of this discussion.

5. Annual Report

The Committee will discuss and take possible action as it relates to the development of the Committee's annual report. This report is due in August of 2017.

The Committee will review comments and determine whether action is necessary; the Committee will only be able to address items that are not on the agenda.

The Committee may vote to go into Executive Session for discussion and consultation with the DCS General Counsel regarding agenda items 1-6 above pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3).
