



Summary Report	Child Fatality	7/9/15
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1. Victim: Elise Ishimwe – 4-year-old female

2. Was the child residing in the child's home or in an out-of-home placement at the time of the fatality? The child was residing in her home at the time of the fatality.

3. If the victim in the Preliminary Report involved a child residing in the child's home, the following information will be provided:

a. Services being provided to the child, a member of the child's family or the person suspected of the abuse or neglect at the time of the incident and the date of the last contact before the incident between the entity providing services and the person receiving services:

No services were being provided to the family by the Department of Child Safety.

b. Was the child, a member of the child's family or the person suspected of the abuse or neglect the subject of a report for investigation at the time of the incident?

Yes. Elise Ishimwe and members of her family were the subjects of the following report:

On August 12, 2014, a report was received alleging domestic violence in the home toward Elise and other household members by Elise's father. The father was arrested and not allowed to return to the home. The investigation found Elise's mother to be protective of her and she was assessed as safe. The case was pending the completion of the necessary documentation when the fatality occurred.

c. All involvement of the child's parents and of the person suspected of the abuse or neglect in a situation for which a report for investigation was made or in services provided pursuant to this chapter in the five years preceding the incident:

The child's parents were involved in the report received August 12, 2014. DCS has had no prior involvement with Nyirkaneza Mazayire.

d. Any investigation pursuant to a report for investigation concerning the child, a member of the child's family or the person suspected of the abuse or neglect or services provided to the child or the child's family since the date of the incident involving the fatality:

The investigation of the fatality report found the other children in the home to be safe. The family was provided with information on available community resources. No subsequent reports of abuse or neglect have been received.

A Fatality/Near Fatality Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) reviewed the case and determined that although this was a tragic accident and not a case of intentional neglect, the fatality may have been prevented if the child had adequate supervision.
