Near Fatality

The date the child suffered the near fatality: 1/10/2013

Child's name: Lorin

Age at time of incident: 8 Months

City, town or general location of residence of the child and perpetrator(s): At the time of the incident, the child and alleged perpetrator(s) were living in Scottsdale, Arizona.

A. Circumstances of the fatality or near fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:

On January 10, 2013, the Scottsdale Police received a 911 call regarding Lorin who was unresponsive, cool to the touch and having difficulty breathing. The parents, Anna McKiernan and Timothy Moore, reported they had found Lorin in this condition after checking on him while he was napping. Drug paraphernalia was found inside the home. Lorin was resuscitated and admitted to the pediatric intensive care unit with life threatening conditions. It was later determined he had an ischemic brain injury and seizure disorder due to oxycodone and caffeine intoxication. He was also found to have a healing rib fracture of unknown origin. The parents provided inconsistent accounts of the injuries.

B. Whether CPS has received any reports or past cases of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child and the current alleged abusive or neglectful parent, guardian or custodian* :

Arizona Child Protective Services (CPS) has not received any prior reports alleging abuse or neglect of Lorin by Anna McKiernan or Timothy Moore.

1. Actions taken by CPS in response to the fatality or near fatality of the child including:

Arizona Child Protective Services (CPS) conducted a joint investigation with the Scottsdale Police Department.

2. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:

Following an assessment of safety, Lorin was placed in foster care and his sibling was placed with a relative.

3. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:

Case management, parent aide, visitation, substance abuse and psychological services were offered to the family.

*Posted information provides whether there have been reports or any current or past cases of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child who has died or suffered a near fatality and the current alleged abusive or neglectful parent, guardian or custodian pursuant to A.R.S. § 8-807(F)(2)(a)(iv).
