Circumstances of the fatality or near fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:

On August 18, 2014, the Department of Child Safety received a report stating that 20-month-old Victoria was in extremely critical condition after a near-drowning incident. Victoria was in the care of her mother, Phoeteama Neal, who has been arrested on one count of attempted first degree murder.

Whether DCS has received any reports or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child and the current alleged abusive or neglectful parent, guardian or custodian*:

DCS has received no prior reports of abuse or neglect involving Victoria and Phoeteama Neal.

1. Actions taken by DCS in response to the fatality or near fatality of the child including:

The Department of Child Safety, in conjunction with the Office of Child Welfare Investigations, is conducting a joint investigation with the Goodyear Police Department.

2. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:

Victoria remains hospitalized in critical condition. There are no other children in the home.

3. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:

Services will be determined upon completion of the investigation.

*Posted information provides whether there have been reports, or any current or past cases, of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child who has died or suffered a near fatality and the current alleged abusive or neglectful parent, guardian or custodian pursuant to A.R.S. § 8-807(F)(2)(a)(iv).
