



Arizona ETV

ETV provides up to \$5,000 per academic year to current and former foster youth for school-related expenses. Participating students work with a Student Advisor and receive campus-based coaching and financial assistance.

AZ ETV Eligibility Requirements

- In tribal or state foster care on or after 16th birthday.
- Adoption from foster care finalized after 16th birthday.
- Exited care to guardianship or reunification after 16th birthday.
- U.S. citizen or qualified non-citizen.
- Younger than 21 to apply for the first time.
- ETV recipients must be making satisfactory progress in school by age 21, to remain eligible for continued funding to age 23.
- Accepted into or enrolled in a degree, certificate or other accredited program at a college, university, technical or vocational school.
- The maximum number of years a student can receive ETV funding is five (5) years.
