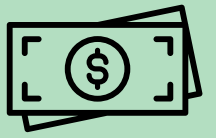

HOW OFTEN IS THIS COURSE OFFERED?

- The Department's goal is to offer **once a month in-person** trainings and **once a week virtual trainings**. While the department is determined to maintain these goals, please note the frequency of these trainings can be subject to change in case of unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT WILL YOU NEED?

For virtual trainings:

- A device with a camera and microphone.
- Device to complete the Kahoot
- Strong service connection
- Availability to attend the whole training.

For in person trainings:

- A device to complete the Kahoot. (Paper options will be available if needed)
- Availability to attend the whole training

In order to ensure you pass the online course you must have your camera on at all times. For both virtual and in person, you must attend the whole training and you will be asked to speak as part of your participation.

- Additional programs may be approved on a case by case basis



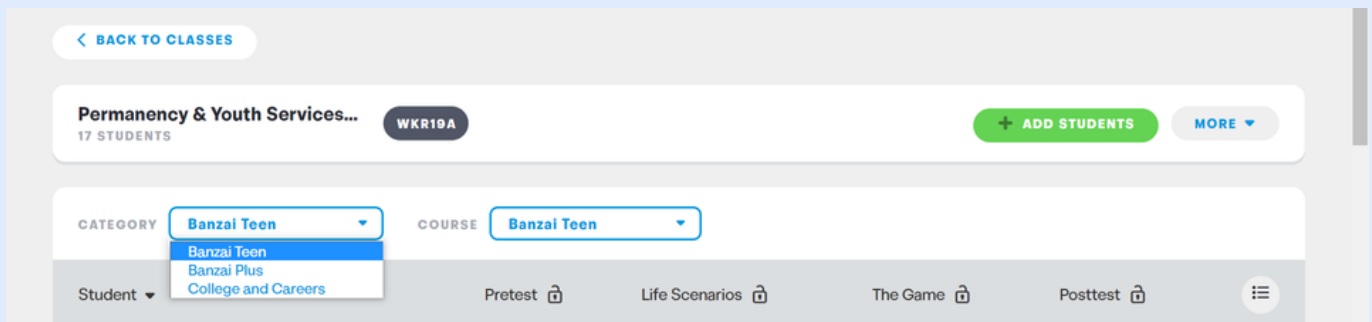
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BANZAI ONLINE TRAINING

This online option is ideal for persons who need the flexibility to participate in a self-paced course where they can log in and out as often as needed to complete the course.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- The first step to completing this training is to create a student account. **Please use an active email.** You must complete the following “categories”: Banzai Teen and Banzai Plus to complete the course. The third category in the dropdown menu (pictured below), College and Careers, is NOT required but does provide a lot of good information, so feel free to complete this category at any time.



- You will need a device (phone, tablet, laptop or desktop) with internet connection to complete the course. We recommend utilizing a laptop or other device with a large screen for ease in navigating the courses. We also recommend that you schedule specific time(s) to complete the coursework, and to set a “due date” for yourself.
