WHEN TO REFER TO A HEALTHY FAMILIES ARIZONA PROGRAM: If you are working with a pregnant woman or a family of a newborn baby who is under the age of 3 months, who may have risk factors, especially mental health issues and/or domestic violence, drug abuse, bonding and attachment issues, and they may benefit from intensive weekly visits, you can make a referral to the Healthy Families program in your community.

All Healthy Families assessment must occur and the program voluntarily accepted by the family prior to the target baby turning three months of age.
