**City, town or general location of residence of the child and perpetrator(s):** Both the child and alleged perpetrator were residing in Phoenix at the time of the incident.

**A. Circumstances of the fatality or near fatality that indicate it was the result of abuse or neglect:**

On August 14, 2010, the mother, Jenna Winget, woke up from 17 hours of sleeping to find Pilot wedged head first between the wall and the bed, which resulted in his suffocation. Mother called 911 and paramedics declared Pilot deceased at the residence. Mother appeared to be under the influence as evidenced by her slurred speech, unsteady gait and mannerisms consistent with substance abuse.

**B. Whether CPS has received any reports or past cases of child abuse, abandonment or neglect involving the child and the current alleged abusive or neglectful parent, guardian or custodian\* :**

CPS had received one prior report alleging abuse of Pilot while in the care of Jenna. The report was received on August 28, 2009, when Jenna gave birth to a substance exposed new born, Pilot. The report was unsubstantiated. The family agreed to participate in an intensive in-home services program as well as counseling until the case was closed in February 2010.

**1. Actions taken by CPS in response to the fatality or near fatality of the child including:**

CPS jointly investigated the allegations with the Phoenix Police Department.

**2. Actions taken regarding the child and/or other children in the home:**

There are no other children in the home.

**3. Whether the agency is or intends to provide direct services or service referrals to the family:**

The investigation has been closed; no services were provided.
